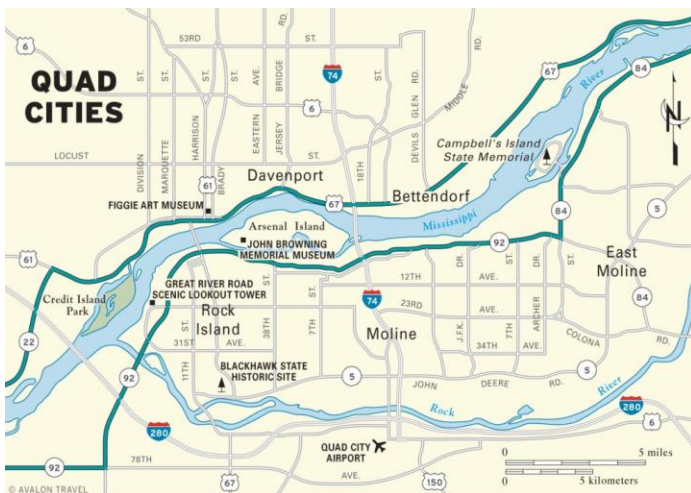

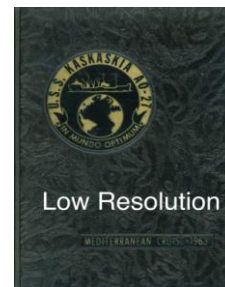

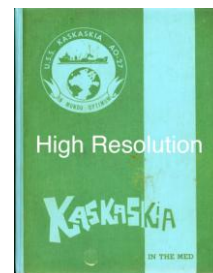

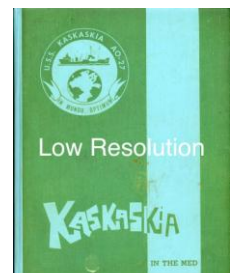

2023 Reunion Meeting Minutes

September 16, 2023

Buffalo NY

President Mike Valsamy called the meeting to order. Board members present: Don Seymour, Mike Valsamy, Larry Kish

Ten additional members present: Dennis Butterfield, Bob Crosbie, Don Grout, Rolf Heinzl, Richard Jones, Dave Lutman, Ben Pfister, Jerry Sheets, Jimmy Tabb, and James Washburn.

Pledge and prayer were led by Jimmy Tabb. Names of deceased since last reunion were recognized when read by Mike Valsamy.

Minutes of the last meeting were read by Larry Kish. Motion to approve as read by Bob Crosbie, seconded by Jimmy Tabb. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Ed Scheid is being treated for cancer and was unable to attend the reunion. In his absence the treasurer's report was given by Don Seymour. Don reported that Ed sent a check to him for \$1523.95 on 20-Mar-2023. Don subsequently cut a check for \$311.84 to cover cost of Blast, and a check for \$155.76 for Kaskaskia Web Hosting. Current balance is \$1871.00 including dues collected and sales of hats and pins. There was some discussion of the apparent discrepancy reported at last year's reunion, \$3037 or \$3110 and the \$1523.95 check transferred to Don Seymour in March. Bob Crosbie made a motion that Mike Valsamy contact Ed Scheid for an accounting of the discrepancy. Motion was seconded by Dennis Butterfield. Motion carried.

Don Seymour suggested that the Treasurer position be the responsibility of the reunion coordinator. Don motioned that going forward the reunion coordinator should also be Treasurer. Second by Richard Jones. Motion carried.

New Business:

Ben Pfister queried about the number of shipmates on the Blast mailing list and the typical attendance at the reunions. Ben suggested that the 2024 reunion be held in the Quad Cities area, including Rock Island, Moline, and East Moline in Illinois, and Davenport and Bettendorf Iowa. Jimmy Tabb motioned that the 2024 reunion be in Quad Cities area, coordinated by Ben Pfister. Motion seconded by Bob Crosbie. Motion carried.

Larry Kish brought up the cost of maintaining the Kaskaskia reunion web page. The cost of the hosting server and domain server has risen from \$131.28 for 2017, to \$155.76 for 2023, and \$233.98 for 2024. In view of the increasing cost Larry asked if it was time to drop the web site. General feeling was that we should continue to maintain the web site. Richard Jones made the motion that Larry should look for cheaper alternatives. If a cheaper hosting server is not found before the October 1 renewal

date, we should continue at the \$233.98 rate for 2024 with the current hosting server. Motion seconded by Jimmy Tabb. Motion carried.

Jimmy Tabb brought up the need to elect officers for the coming year. He made a motioned that following slate be elected for the coming year:

Secretary – Larry Kish

Historian – Mike Valsamy

Motion seconded by Bob Crosbie. Motion carried.

Jimmy Tabb motioned that Don Seymour be vice president. Ben Pfister seconded. Motion carried.

Traveled the farthest – Dennis Butterfield 1174 miles.

Traveled the least – Don Seymour 7 miles.

Oldest – Bob Crosbie 84

Youngest – Mike Valsamy 76

Motion to adjourn by Bob Crosbie. Second by Jerry Sheets. Motion carried.

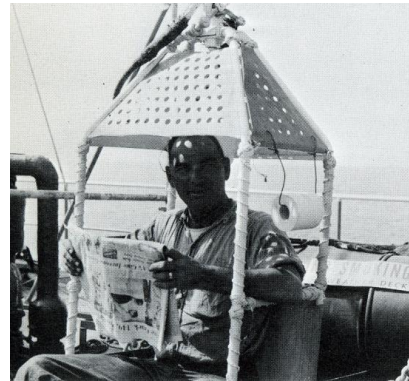

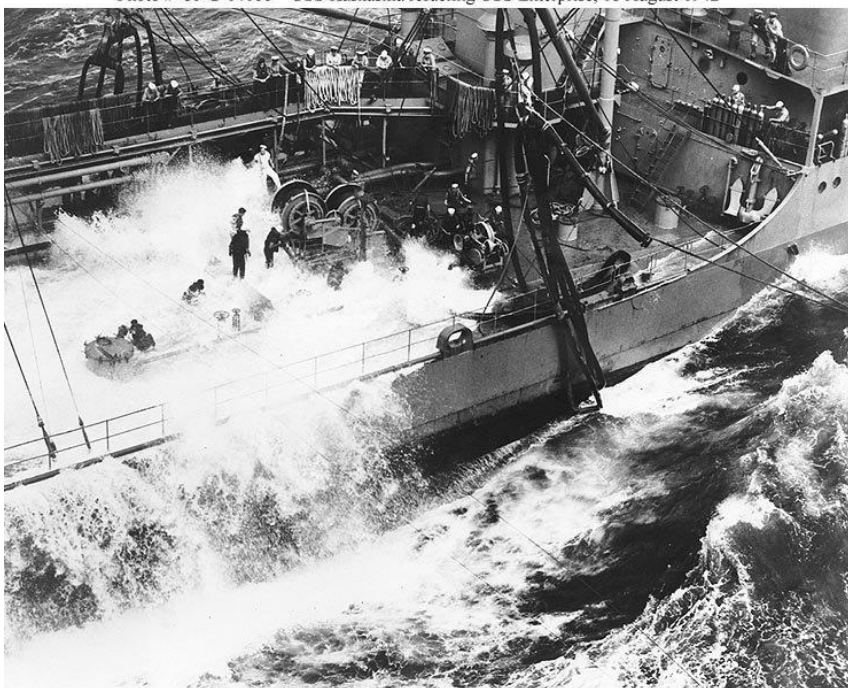
